You've tried mulled wine, now try Tring's own mulled apple juice

It's available from the village shop and can be enjoyed at any time. However, now the nights are drawing in you might like to try a traditional winter warmer drink using Tring's Own Apple Juice - mulled with orange and spices.

Here's the recipe:

Ingredients

1 bottle of Tring's Own Apple Juice

Strips of orange peel from one orange

1 cinnamon stick

2 cloves

Honey to taste

Method

Step 1
